Join FAR Australia's Nick Poole and Ben Morris in the field – Looking at the risks and rewards of disease management in the HRZ.

This field walk will provide you with an opportunity to look at the RiskWi\$e canola N Bank trial and AGF seeds cereal site. There is also an opportunity to bring along powdery mildew samples for resistance testing.

*Powdery Mildew instructions: collect plants as close to field day as possible. Dig out whole plants with roots attached to a soil ball. Place whole plant in a plastic bag with enough water to moisten soil. Include name, contact details, variety and location.*



RiskWi\$e (the National Risk Management Initiative), is a 5-year national initiative of around \$30 million that will run from 2023 to 2028. It seeks to understand and improve the risk-reward outcomes for Australian grain growers by supporting grower on-farm decision making.
