Jason is a practical soil science researcher with an interest in real world soil issues, communicating an understanding of agronomically relevant soil mechanisms to end users, and raising the awareness of soils within the broader community.

- Comparisons of pulse species for grain yield and nitrogen fixation Including varieties of faba beans, lupins, field peas, vetch, chickpeas, and lentils.
- Fungicide management strategies in faba beans.
- pH stratification and the implications for pulse productivity
- Comparison of new main season wheat and barley varieties being evaluated in FAR Australia's Germplasm Evaluation Network.
- Management options for control of wheat powdery mildew in Southern NSW Variety choice, fungicide products, and strategic use of new actives in the fungicide program.
